261 W. Rittenhouse RCO Meeting

The 59th Ward, as the coordinating RCO, has announced an **In person** meeting to be held on Tuesday June 24 at 6:30 PM at Face To Face located at 123 E. Price Street.

Zoned RSA-5 (Residential Single Family Attached), the applicant is applying for a use variance to operate a commercial business on the premises. Attend the meeting to better understand the variance request and how it may effect neighbors.



Our neighbors, the senior residents at Four Freedoms have been meeting with the city for 2 years for a simple immediate solution to a dangerous situation near Morris Street. Since the city does not yet have the money to pay for the entire Walnut Lane Complete Streets Improvement Project, at the very least, they should be able to program the existing light at Four Freedoms to be a fully functioning green, yellow, and red traffic light. Right now, that light is always green for the speeding cars. Pedestrians must push a button, which doesn't always work, to make the 15 second red light across to the SEPTA bus stop. If

you haven't already, please <u>sign the petition</u> to urge the Streets Department to at least make this a fully functioning traffic light. Another protest is scheduled at that light on June 28 at noon. Please join us!

Where did the fashionable Germantown ladies and gentlemen go for a five-course luncheon in the '50s? At the Boswell House, customers dined in one of four dining rooms to their famous Steer Liver and Onions, scallops with tartar sauce and broiled chopped sirloin. For over thirty years Boswell House was a Germantown favorite.

Fast forward to 1991 when Ellen Rose
Appelbaum, of the Chestnut Hill Spice Shop
Fame, opened her eponymous restaurant, Ellen
Rose. With husband Noyma at the hosting, the
popular BYOB drew customers from all around.
The restaurant served its last meal in 1996 yet to
this day older residents still say, 'That was Ellen
Rose' when they pass the corner of Greene and
Haines.

Today the building is vacant and for sale. Some of the kitchen amenities are still in place and they have plenty of parking. Pass the word among your foodie friends in case they know someone interested in opening a new restaurant.


