# 226 Harvey ZBA Decision Pending

At least 15 neighbors attended the ZBA Hearing held 11/19 to voice their opposition to a variance request to convert the property to 6 residential units. Our Zoning Chair, Julie Stapleton Carroll, testified in person and made the strong case for the ZBA to deny the variance. ZBA Chair Bergman decided to bring the case before their Executive Board on December 3. Interested neighbors can hear the announcement of that
