#### **Restrictive Preservation Bill Paused**

Voting on Bill No. 251030, introduced to City Council on 11/20 by Council member Mark Squilla has, for a time, been paused as Philadelphia's Planning Commission, testimony from preservation leaders, community organizations like WCGN, and your letters have delayed voting for 45 days with hopes that the bill is rewritten to level the playing field for all parties. Read Chestnut Hill Conservancy's statement of opposition which explains well our position. We will keep you informed when the bill comes before City Council. Your emails to all members of City Council will be necessary if the bill goes forward without major changes. Stay tuned.
